#### Educational program passport

- 1.Mission of educational program: To be a recognized leader in competitive training, meeting the resident physician's need to achieve learning outcomes, providing the health care system and society with highly qualified psychiatrists.
- 2.Purpose of educational program: training of qualified, competitive personnel who meets modern requirements for the quality of physicians to perform independent professional activities as a psychiatrist.

#### Objectives of educational program:

- 1. advanced study and mastering the theoretical sections of psychiatry;
- improving practical skills in modern principles of diagnosis, interpretation of the results of the examination from the position of evidentiary medicine;
- 3. individual performance of qualified medical care for various conditions and diseases.

#### 3. Justification of the educational program:

Psychiatry is a branch of medicine that studies mental illnesses related to a very special set of disorders. Mental illnesses occur even if the brain is healthy and there are no organic disorders (injuries, foci of infection, tumors, circulatory disorders). However, mental illness can be associated with organic pathology. An example here would be psychoses associated with age-related changes in the functioning of the brain. Characteristic of psychiatry are precisely those diseases in which the functioning of the psyche is clearly impaired (a person suffers for no reason, sits in a stupor, sees hallucinations, shows unmotivated aggression, believes that he is being watched, etc.). But psychiatry not only studies and classifies mental illnesses, but also treats them. The main treatment method used today in psychiatry is drug treatment. There is a field of pharmacology specifically designed to create cures for mental illness - psychopharmacology.Residency in psychiatry involves a more in-depth study of the systemicfunctional principle of illuminating anatomical and physiological information about the nervous system, training in techniques for identifying individual symptoms (reflexes, tests, tests), in the light of new neurophysiological data, consideration of the organizations of brain function on a systemic principle, the values of neurotransmitters and neuropeptides, conducting modern methods of additional research of psychiatric patients, including radionuclide methods, computed tomography nuclear magnetic resonance, as well as studying the problems most often encountered in the practice of a psychiatrist vascular diseases of the nervous system, infectious and inflammatory diseases, epilepsy and other convulsive syndromes, diseases of the peripheral nervous system.
